



## DISCOUNTS

**Early Registration:** Take \$20 (\$10 from Beginners or Samplers) off the regular price of camp by registering before March 19.

**Multiple Child Discount:** You will receive a discount of \$10 for each additional sibling registered if not using a campership.

## CAMPERSHIPS

Your church congregation may pay a portion of the camp fee. Please check with your church's camp representative. Camperships are also available through the camp for families needing financial assistance.

Requests for camperships should be made in writing and accompany the registration form along with a note from your pastor stating the need.

## CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations received 30 days prior to your camp date will receive a full refund minus a \$25 processing fee. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to your camp date will receive ½ of the registration fee minus a \$25 processing fee. If a child does not arrive for camp, all registration fees are forfeited.

## PERSONAL CONDUCT INFORMATION

Church camp is about living in Christian Community. In an attempt to provide an atmosphere where children can live together in that community, the campers are expected to: participate and cooperate in activities, respect one another, use no profanity, wear modest and appropriate clothing and have a behavior that is not disruptive to

the program. The camp reserves the right to send home a camper who is unable to function within these guidelines.
