

Employment at a summer camp is a unique opportunity. It is more than a just a job. It is ministry in service to others. A spirit and attitude of service and mission must under gird your decision to apply for this position. This is an opportunity that calls for sacrifice. Much will be demanded of you and the flip side of those demands is the transformation that you see in others as well as in yourself, especially in the lives of the children that you serve.

You will be working with a team of 30 or more people during some very intense times and experiences. These experiences will stretch your comfort zones and may even move you out of your comfort zone. It is therefore necessary that you see that a summer camp position is also about being a professional and working and living a life of honesty and integrity. You will be relied on by others to be there when needed. The flip side is that you will want others there for you when you need them. Working with honesty and integrity will build those relationships that will help support you throughout the summer.

The summer staff position is a salaried position with 50 hours per week being the normal work week. During your employment you will be asked to model a lifestyle and value system that is consistent with a Christian tradition that calls for us to “live in the world, not of the world.”

Qualifications include:

- Healthy spiritual life and a desire to follow a life in Christ.
- Good moral character and integrity.
- Good physical and mental health.
- Emotional maturity.
- Ability to work as a member of a team.
- Interest in contributing to the achievement of the camp’s objectives and impacting the lives of others.



Summer Staff positions are available in all areas of operation including food service, facilities, office, waterfront, and program. Some may be part of a core team in each area of operation. Work schedules will vary weekly and daily as staffing needs are assigned.
