**Camp Mack Mission Statement:** Camp Alexander Mack provides a sanctuary where people connect with God, experience creation, and build Christian community!

**Position Description:** The Camp Nurse will evaluate and treat campers and staff for minor injuries and illnesses, supervise and ensure the implementation of medication policies and procedures at camp, keep a log of Health Center visits, give supportive advice to counselors and other camp staff if requested, and identify health problems serious enough to require a physician's attention. The health office nurse is available 24/7 when campers are on site. This position includes room and board and opportunities for summer camp environment and recreation.

## **Qualifications:**

- 1. RN degree (licensed in the State of Indiana)
- 2. Current certification in Adult/Child CPR/AED and First Aid
- 3. Desire to work in a variety of environments and schedules
- 4. Ability to make treatment decisions within physician standing orders
- 5. Friendly, approachable, and compassionate
- 6. Enjoy working with children
- 7. Enjoy an active lifestyle.
- 8. Ability to interact with campers ages 6-18
- 9. Work experience with children is not required, but a plus

### Responsibilities

- 1. Use non-pharmaceutical interventions to mitigate COVID and other illnesses
- 2. Caring for the medical needs of campers and staff at Camp
- 3. Oversee the health and wellness of approximately 80-100 campers and staff/summer volunteers each week
- 4. Oversee volunteers to perform an initial health screening of all campers and staff
- 5. Provide medical attention to campers and staff with general health concerns and document in health log
- 6. Secure, distribute, and record camper use of medications according to prescribed instructions
- 7. Maintain Health Center records and medical forms
- 8. Communicate specific camper health needs (allergies, special diets) to staff as needed
- 9. Communicate with the Program Director about camper health issues

- 10. Provide for proper nursing intervention regarding camper and/or staff illness, condition, or emergency care and make appropriate referrals, providing follow up care as warranted
- 11. Complete and follow up on incident reports
- 12. Communicate with parents in conjunction with management staff
- 13. Work with office staff to ensure adequate supplies in the health center and mobile first aid kits

#### **Season Dates**

The Camp Nurse is employed June 20-July 30. The typical work week is Sunday noon through Friday 9:00 PM. (Will be required to work through Saturday 11:00 AM on July 3 and July 10.)

## **Compensation and Benefits**

Housing and meals and provided. Pay is \$350 a week paid on the 10<sup>th</sup> and the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month.

## **Expectations**

- 1. Function as the primary health provider for Church of the Brethren camps
- 2. Consult with management staff regarding health and safety concerns
- 3. Meet regularly with the Program Director to coordinate special circumstances
- 4. Participate as a full member of camp community.
