PERSONAL CONDUCT- Church camp is about living in Christian community. The camp reserves the right to send home a camper who is unable to function within these guidelines.

Should it become necessary for him/her to return home during the week because of illness, accident, homesickness, or conduct, I will abide by the camp's decision in this matter and provide transportation. I understand, also, that although the camp has taken precaution to provide proper supervision instruction, training, and equipment for each activity, it is impossible for the camp to guarantee absolute safety. I further understand that my child/ward shares responsibility for his/her safety and I have instructed my child/ward in the importance of knowing and abiding by camp rules, regulations, and procedures for the safety of the camp participant.

Further, I waive any claim that may arise against the camp and/or employees as a result of participation in the program, except for those that are a direct result of gross negligence of the camp or its employees.
