

YOUTH CAMP COVENANT

Camp Alexander Mack

1. Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, or tobacco on Camp Mack premises.
2. Automobiles are off limits from 5PM on Sunday until 11AM Saturday.
3. Youth Camp is a closed camp. This means that campers will not be allowed to leave during the week. Exceptions must be in writing and APPROVED by Camp Council prior to camp. Friends and family will NOT be allowed to visit during the week.
4. Attendance at all organized sessions, including workshops and meals, is mandatory.
5. All of the rules of Camp Alexander Mack are in effect and will be enforced.
6. No girls in guys' cabins or guys in girls' cabins without a counselor present.
7. You will need to be in your cabin (already done in the bathroom) 15 minutes before lights out for evening devotions.
8. We encourage that you do not bring electronic devices (including blow dryers and curling irons). Camp is a place to be yourself & conserve energy. iPods will be allowed for use during rest period only and only with headphones.
9. Keep in mind that swimsuits are for waterfront activities only. Please, dress with modesty and discretion throughout the week.
10. Remember this is a church camp. Foul and hurtful language is inappropriate.
11. Cell phones are not to be used during the week of camp.
12. No fireworks are to be brought to camp.
