TEAM BUILDING

Camp's qualified instructors will lead your group through a variety of team building activities to increase your group's effectiveness. In addition to high-interest, low-impact activities, we offer: a low ropes course; 32-foot climbing tower with multiple levels of difficulty; a 350-foot zip line from the top of our climbing tower; and a multi-level high ropes course.

SWIMMING & BOATING

Certified lifeguards supervise all waterfront activities including: sailing, canoeing, kavaking, row-boating, and swimming. Swimming is available Memorial Day through Labor Day, and boating is available May through mid-October.

OUTDOOR EDUCATION

We offer more than 30 field study options tied to state standards that include optional pre- and post-lessons for back in the classroom. Field studies include adventure, environmental science, and outdoor skills options. We offer day and overnight programs, custom-built to your school's learning objectives. Fall and spring sessions are available. Call or email for details.

DINING FACILITIES

The Kate Warstler Dining Center, located in the John Kline Welcome Center, has dining for up to 300 guests with flexible rooms to accommodate various group sizes. Dining Room A alone has space for 180. Dining Rooms B and C each have a capacity of 60 people. Call for catered event details.

MEETING AREAS

The Turkey Creek Meeting Room is a fully equipped conference room in the John Kline Welcome Center. Additional three-season meeting spaces include: Shultz Chapel—a quiet lakeside spot for worship, meditation, and special gatherings accommodating up to 65; and Quinter Miller Auditorium for larger groups and special events of up to 750 guests. Retreat & Rental Accommodations













JOHN KLINE WELCOME CENTER This building houses the Manly Deeter Office Center and the Kate Warstler Dining Center. As you enter the main entrance, a spacious gathering area greets you with a fireplace, comfy chairs, a fish tank, pianos, and a library. Just off the gathering area are restrooms, the Gift Shoppe, and the John Kline Meeting Room. The large dining room can be divided to accommodate three groups. Serving options include buffet line, family style, or banquet style. Dining capacity: 300+.

SARAH MAJOR LODGE As multi-level lakeside lodging, Sarah Major Lodge includes: a spacious meeting room with views of the lake on the main floor, a wood-burning fireplace, and a kitchenette; recreation/meeting area and kitchen located on the lower level; three bedrooms on the main level and five bedrooms on the upper level; and centrally located restrooms and showers. This lodge is heated. Overnight capacity: 64 summer setup/47 most of retreat season (35 are lower or single twin beds).

ULRICH HOUSE—NEWLY RENOVATED! (Remodeling completed by March 2023) Ulrich House is a newly remodeled,

multi-level retreat lodge filled with rustic charm and includes: a main floor meeting space with a kitchenette and a wood-burning fireplace; a main floor conference room connected to a kitchen; recreation/meeting area located on the lower level that walks out to a covered back porch; 14 total bedrooms on the main and upper levels; and restrooms on the main and upper levels. A new elevator connects all three floors. This lodge has heating and air conditioning. Overnight capacity: 33 with one person per bed/48 with two people per full size bed. No bunks.

WAMPLER RETREAT CENTER This lakeside retreat lodge includes: a cozy meeting area with a kitchen and a wood-burning fireplace; four carpeted bedrooms; centrally located restrooms and showers; and a wood deck with a view of the lake. This lodge is heated. Overnight capacity: 20 (12 are lower or single twin beds).

MISSION VILLAGE YURTS The Mission Village wooden yurts are three-season retreat lodging that include: a central meeting yurt that can accommodate up to 45 people; heated restrooms with showers; and five lodging yurts all connected by a central boardwalk. Four yurts have ten beds, and one has three to six beds. Overnight sleeping capacity: 45

SEASONAL CABINS Six three-season cabins include accommodations for up to 60 guests (W Cabins). These have heating capabilities and twin beds, not bunks. There are fifteen cabins available from May–September (E Cabins and Letter Cabins). One of the Letter Cabins has single twin beds; the rest have twin bunk beds. These cabins accommodate up to 150 combined. Each area has a centrally located bathhouse (restrooms and showers) and a nearby campfire circle.

Registration for summer camps and Grand Camps will open February 1st, 2023

DEPOSITS

To be fully registered for a summer camp, a non-refundable deposit of \$75 must be received. If a deposit is not received, your spot for the camp is not reserved. Full payment is expected by June 1st.

To be fully registered for a retreat or event, fees must be paid in full to reserve your spot.

REFUND POLICY

Any cancellations received 30 days prior to your camp start date will receive a full refund minus the \$75 deposit. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to your camp start date will receive a refund of ½ of the registration minus the \$75 deposit. If a child does not arrive for camp, all registration fees are forfeited.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SUMMER CAMPS


